The actuators are suitable for use in current circuits with a maximum short-circuit 1-phase AC current value of 5,000 A root-mean-square (R.M.S). The output data of the fuses to be provided on site must not exceed the following values: 32 A/600 V at a maximum mains mains short circuit current of 5,000 A AC.

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Motor protection	To protect against overheating, PTC thermistors are embedded in the motor windings.
